Nocturne 'sr' 2020 sangiovese nebbiolo rosé *"Local Rosé"* Margaret River \$950 | \$47

5th VINTAGE SMALL FAMILY PROJECT BY LOCAL (DEEP WOODS ESTATE) WINEMAKER JULIAN LANGWORTHY & ALANA LANGWORTHY
Mostly sangiovese, 17% nebbiolo grown especially for rosé from the sub region of Carunup in Margaret River hot flatlands, perfect for making dry spicy style classic rosé. *"A pale salmon dream, texture and acid structure, a beacon of deliciousness, extreme drinkability, in a year you might need it" JL* (unfined /vegan)

La Violetta 'YÉ- YÉ' Rouge 2019 pinot noir | syrah | meunier Mount Barker & Frankland River WA \$950 | \$47

Inspired blend rich ruby colour, fruit forward aromas, elegant flavours. Pinot and meunier both from Denmark, for cooler climate influences, lifted red fruits, herbal notes; the syrah (shiraz) from Mount Barker, adds mid-weight juices and spices. Whole bunch adds savoury notes and high-tone spice seamless melding of pinot and shiraz. (unfined/vegan)

Classic local cab with some merlot– *mulberry, blackberry, briar patch with fine tannins and a cool finish* (unfined/vegan)

Attollo 2018 cabernet sauvignon Wilyabrup Vineyards, Margaret River \$850 | \$42

Fruit from 23yo vines planted '95, Pusey Rd, Wilyabrup, organic practices, "hands-off" approach, biodynamic principles hand harvested March 24, 2018 [Biodynamic fruit day] basket pressed 20% new Fr Oak. One of the classic vintages in Margaret River. *Beautiful perfume, rich ripe flavours, ripe tannin, long savoury finish.* (unfined/unfiltered/vegan)

Vasse Felix 2019 'black market - project malbec 1' WINE BY CORAVIN 150 ml Margaret River \$12 | \$59

ONE OF THE REGION'S FOUNDING WINERIES, MALBEC FROM THEIR FIRST PLANTINGS IN THE HOME VINEYARD 1967 (AND FORM PART OF THE ICONIC TOM CULLITY CAB BLEND) Winemaker Virginia Willcock and crew. Whole bunch carbonic maceration, wild fermentation, basket pressed, French oak. *Bright deep maroon purple colour. Aromas dark ripe mulberry, anise, savoury, mushroom. Vibrant mulberry cranberry flavours, elegant, dry, tannic finish.* (vegan)

SMALL PROJECT BY LOCAL FAMILY WINEMAKERS GENEVIEVE & ROB MANN (EX CAPE MENTELLE) *Corymbia: Marri Tree growing tall in the vineyards.* The realisation of a dream seeded by Rob's Grandfather, Jack Mann. 2nd release from dry grown, organically farmed 'Calgardup vineyard', 2km inland from the famous Redgate Beach off Caves Road south. Fresh and vibrant as the pristine coastal location of its origin. *"Tastes of the grape, the dirt and the sea without pretention and exudes all of the characters of Margaret River Cabernet that the world admires."* Rob Mann (unfined/vegan)

56% Cab Sauv, 16% Malbec, 13% Merlot, 9% Petit Verdot and 6% Cab Franc. *Bright, dense, crimson- classic Wilyabrup Valley violet, brambly red fruits, French oak. Red, dark berry fruits, dark cocoa flavours, gravelly tannin and fine acidity.* (unfined/vegan)

Vineyards around the outskirts of Châteauneuf du Pâpe AOP preserving the unique traditional methods. *Delicious, vibrant freshness, lush warm tones, generous, satisfying richness.* (unfined/unfiltered/vegan)

Serrat 'fourre-tout' 2019 barbera, malbec, pinot, nebbiolo, grenache Yarra Valley, Vic WINE BY CORAVIN 150 ml \$12 | \$60

EST '01 BY NADEGE SUNE & HUSBAND TOM CARSON (SHOW JUDGE; EX YERING STATION; NOW RUNS YABBY LAKE & HEATHCOTE ESTATE)

Fourre-tout 'catchall' bringing together all the tiny bits and pieces on the new plantings, close-planted, co-fermented, 80% whole berry, 20% whole bunch, creating a new delicious, interesting wine, not dominated by one variety, captures the essence of each variety, individually: Barbera richness, savoury Malbec and Nebbiolo. Fragrant Grenache. Deep colour; black fruits, blackberry, plum aromas and a spicy kick from the Malbec. Brambly blackcurrant notes, juicy and rich with chewy tannins.
