5<sup>th</sup> VINTAGE SMALL FAMILY PROJECT BY LOCAL (DEEP WOODS ESTATE) WINEMAKER JULIAN LANGWORTHY & ALANA LANGWORTHY  
Mostly sangiovese, 17% nebbiolo grown especially for rosé from the sub region of Carunup in Margaret River hot flatlands, perfect for making dry spicy style classic rosé. *"A pale salmon dream, texture and acid structure, a beacon of deliciousness, extreme drinkability, in a year you might need it" JL* (unfined /vegan)

**Voyager Estate 'sparkling red' grape juice** estate-grown grapes, Zero alcohol 330ml bottle Margaret River | \$6

**Garagiste 'le stagiare' 2019 pinot noir** Mornington Peninsula Vic \$11 | \$55  
SMALL PROJECT BY BARNEY FLANDERS FOCUSING ON FRUIT FROM THE MORNINGTON PENINSULA REGION *Sophisticated, vibrant, savoury almost gamay-like with tart raspberry, fresh-cut violet. Pomegranate, red berried pinot with loads of energy.* (unfined /vegan)

Classic local cab with some merlot– *mulberry, blackberry, briar patch with fine tannins and a cool finish* (unfined/vegan)

**Jilyara of Wilyabrup 'honeycomb corner' 2018 cabernet sauvignon** Margaret River \$850 | \$42  
FAMILY WINERY CRAIG COTTERELL & PARTNER MARIA BERGSTROM PLANTED VINEYARDS 1995 – WINEMAKERS KATE MORGAN, LAURA BOWLER - JILYARA FROM 'DJILYARO' MEANING BEES IN THE LOCAL NOONGAR LANGUAGE *Elegant cab with small amounts of merlot and malbec. Black berry fruits, rich ripe flavours, dark chocolate fine tannins, subtle oak, long fruity finish.* 'Great value!' James Halliday, 93 pts WINE COMPANION

**Beneath the Kite 2017 malbec** » Inspired by local novel CRUSH by Vicki Messenger « Margaret River \$11 | \$55  
NEW SMALL PROJECT HAND-CRAFTED BY MARK MESSENGER – (LOCALLY RENOWNED WINEMAKER AT JUNIPER ESTATE 20 VINTAGES)  
15 yo vines from Kelly's vineyard just north of Driftwood. Wild yeast, 10% whole bunch. Barrel aged 20% new FR oak 15 mos. *Rich juicy flavours, spicy plum, aniseed, chocolate, dense fine grained tannins.* (lightly filtered /unfined/vegan)

## - Premium Reds by the Glass from Coravin -

**Adelina Estate 2014 grenache** Clare Valley, South Australia WINE BY CORAVIN 150 ml \$11 | \$55  
COL McBRYDE & JENNIE GARDNER'S SMALL FAMILY WINERY (ADELINA & SOME YOUNG PUNKS) EST 2002 – 100 YO VINES PLANTED BY JENNIE'S FAMILY, SPRINGFARM VINEYARD RIGHT NEXT DOOR TO THE FAMED "HALLOWED TURF" VINEYARDS OF WENDOUREE.  
Very old, desiccated grey loams and maturity of the bio-dynamic vines means yields are naturally low. *'Sweet core of red fruits with flashes of blackberry. Pinot-like complexity. Nebbiolo-like textural tannins. Better with age drink until 2024'* (unfined/vegan)

**Serrat 'fourre-tout' 2019 barbera, malbec, pinot, nebbiolo, grenache** Yarra Valley, Vic WINE BY CORAVIN 150 ml \$12 | \$60  
EST '01 BY NADEGE SUNE & HUSBAND TOM CARSON (SHOW JUDGE; EX YERING STATION; NOW RUNS YABBY LAKE & HEATHCOTE ESTATE)  
Fourre-tout 'catchall' bringing together all the tiny bits and pieces on the new plantings, close-planted, co-fermented, 80% whole berry, 20% whole bunch, creating a new delicious, interesting wine, not dominated by one variety, captures the essence of each variety, individually: Barbera richness, savoury Malbec and Nebbiolo. Fragrant Grenache. *Deep colour; black fruits, blackberry, plum aromas and a spicy kick from the Malbec. Brambly blackcurrant notes, juicy and rich with chewy tannins.*

◆ **Woodlands Wines 'clementine' 2017 cab blend** Margaret River PREMIUM WINE BY CORAVIN 100 ml \$10 | \$65  
LOCAL SMALL FAMILY WINERY Est 1973 – WINES MADE BY BROTHERS STUART AND ANDREW WATSON  
56% Cab Sauv, 16% Malbec, 13% Merlot, 9% Petit Verdot and 6% Cab Franc. *Bright, dense, crimson- classic Wilyabrup Valley violet, brambly red fruits, French oak. Red, dark berry fruits, dark cocoa flavours, gravelly tannin and fine acidity.* (unfined/vegan)

◆ **Cape Mentelle 'walcliffe' 2015 merlot | petit verdot** Margaret River PREMIUM WINE BY CORAVIN 100 ml \$14 | \$90  
EST 1970 BY DAVID HOHNEN. FRUIT FROM ORIGINAL VINEYARD PLANTINGS OVER 40YO VINES.  
*"Plum, red berries, ginger, dark choc, savoury. Medium bodied, silky, fluid, earthiness, minerality, acidity, tannin finish, spice, perfume trailing away. Just lovely. Bespoke tailoring. Absolute charmer."* 95pts Gary Walsh WF

SMALL PROJECT BY LOCAL FAMILY WINEMAKERS GENEVIEVE & ROB MANN (EX CAPE MENTELLE, HOUGHTON'S, NEWTON WINES, CA)  
The realisation of a dream seeded by Rob's Grandfather, Jack Mann. 2nd release from dry grown, organically farmed 'Calgardup vineyard' 2km inland from the famous Redgate Beach off Caves Road south. Fresh and vibrant as the pristine coastal location of its origin. *"Tastes of the grape, the dirt and the sea without pretention and exudes all of the characters of Margaret River Cabernet that the world admires."* Rob Mann (unfined/vegan)

SMALL WINEMAKING PROJECT BY MIKE & ANNA PATERSON FROM ORGANIC & BIODYNAMIC EAST SLOPE VINEYARDS Omaka Valley, Marlborough *Supple fruit, regional generosity & plumpness. Dark cherry, choc, strawberry, undergrowth Aromas. Rich dark fruit flavours, soft finish with goods strong tannins.* Great drinking to at least 2022 (unfined/vegan)
