Dhillon 'ranges' 2022 shiraz | merlot TEXTURAL SAVOURY ROSÉ Macedon Ranges, Heathcote Vic 150 ml \$12 | \$55
MICHAEL DHILLON, 2nd GEN, BINDI WINES SMALL FAMILY WINERY "WINEMAKER OF THE YEAR - HALLIDAY WINE COMPANION 2022"
Small parcel from Glenhope Vineyard - wild yeast, old French barrels, 6mos on lees. *Aromas of ripe strawberry, a touch of cream and spice adding a little more complexity; deliciously interesting and food friendly.*

Juniper 'crossings original red' 2021 cab | merlot Margaret River 150 ml \$8 | \$35
EST '73 BY HILL FAMILY, NOW WITH 2ND GEN BROTHERS NICK & TOM HILL & WINEMAKER MARK MESSENGER 20YRS (vegan)

Leeuwin Estate 'siblings' 2020 shiraz Margaret River 150 ml \$950 | \$45
EST '73 BY LOCAL HORGAN FAMILY ONE OF THE FOUNDING LOCAL WINERIES *dense, dark, blackcurrant, blueberry, spice, black pepper.*

Edwards 'matilda' 2021 cabernet sauvignon Margaret River 150 ml \$12 | \$55
CHRISTO & FIONA'S REOPENING OF ONE OF MARG'S FAVE FAMILY WINERIES EST '93 *Complex aromas, black fruits, chocolate, tapenade, earthy, graphite, cedar. Beautiful balance of flavours, deep, dark berry fruit weight, dusty tannins, supportive oak, great length. Cellar Door houses Christo's father Brian's 1943 Tiger Moth 'Matilda' on display, that he flew solo from England to Australia in 1990.*

◆ **Skigh Wines 'longley' 2021 pinot noir** Margaret River 100 ml \$11 ◆ 150 ml \$1550 | \$75
BY LOCAL SKIGH MCMANUS - Fruit from Jacob's Vineyard, off Wickham Rd (just before Witchy) "Longley" Skigh's father's middle name.
Harvested earlier than typical years to ensure varietally true characteristics, natural acid level and minimise alcohol content.
Part whole bunch; basket pressed; 20% new French Burgundian oak, 24 months barrel age for fruit to oak integration.

◆ **William Downie 'cathedral' 2023 pinot noir** Mornington Peninsula, Vic 100 ml \$10 ◆ 150 ml \$1350 | \$65
BILL DOWNIE ESTABLISHED HIS OWN LABEL IN 2003 AFTER WORKING IN BURGUNDY SEVERAL YEARS. His intention is to produce wines of purity and detail that reflect place of origin, made in the most natural way as possible. Blend of 70% Mornington Peninsula /30% King Valley, beautiful organic fruit. *Aromatic, lively, bright, red/dark berry fruit, spicy, finesse, subtle tannins. (Unfined/Unfiltered/Vegan)*

◆ **Vasse Felix 2021 syrah (shiraz)** Margaret River WA 100 ml \$10 ◆ 150 ml \$1350 | \$65
EST '67 FIRST WINERY REGIONAL PIONEER TOM CULLITY, NOW OWNED BY HOLMES À COURT FAMILY SINCE '87. WINEMAKER VIRGINIA WILLCOCK
Cool climate southern Margaret River vineyards—a portion of whole bunch fermentation and carbonic maceration—*aromatic, fine-boned Syrah, luscious, spicy, beautifully complex, a favourite 'alternative' Margaret River red varieties. Vegan*

◆ **Passel Estate 2019 shiraz** Margaret River 100ml \$1050 ◆ 150 ml \$1450 | \$70
2011 WENDY & BARRY STIMPSON TOOK OVER THE VINEYARD AT ELLENBROOK & CAVES RD, VINES PLANTED 1994 WINEMAKER LOCAL BRUCE DUKES
Passel name: After 2011 Margaret River bushfires the Stimpson's provided sanctuary to a Passel (family) of Western Ringtail Possums displaced by the fires, so begun their ongoing support for wildlife. **The shiraz:** *Blackberries, dark choc, spices, texture.*

◆ **Wines of Merritt 2022 mourvèdre** Wilyabrup, Margaret River 100 ml \$10 ◆ 150 ml \$1350 | \$65
SMALL BATCH WINES BY LOCALS NICK & SARAH JAMES-MARTIN they handpicked the grapes over 2 days, late April '22. Half whole bunch fermented, half destemmed, both foot trod; indigenous yeast; basket pressed to Fr oak. Bottled without fining nor filtration.
Mouvèdre originally planted in Spain over 2,000 years ago – this has the distinct 'mouvèdre' personality - strong tannic structure, quite dark-fruited and spicy, with gamey, wild herb aromas. (Vegan)

◆ **Flowstone 2018 touriga** » HALLIDAY TOP 10 BEST VALUE WINERY 2021 « 100 ml \$9 ◆ 150 ml \$1250 | \$60
LOCAL WINEMAKER OWNER STUART PYM, SMALL PROJECT, JUST SOUTH OF MARGARET RIVER TOWNSHIP IN KARRIDALE. Touriga Nacional is a Portuguese dark skinned variety, for both dry red wines and the fortified wines of Oporto (Port). *Bold dark-fruit flavours, cabernet like, with hints of spice, leather and violet. Time in French oak adds soft spices and talc-like tannins to finish.*

◆ **McHenry Hohnen 'bdx' 2021 malbec | cab sauv | petit verdot** Margaret River 100 ml \$10 ◆ 150 ml \$1350 | \$65
EST 1984 FOUNDER MURRAY MCHENRY - WINEMAKER, JACOPO "JAPO" DALLI CANI - CERTIFIED ORGANIC, FARMED BIODYNAMICALLY
Fragrant malbec dominant blend (53/37/10) deep, concentrated, intense, balanced. So drinkable.

◆ **Walsh & Sons 'roi' 2020 cabernet sauvignon** Margaret River WA 100 ml \$11 ◆ 150 ml \$1550 | \$75
LOCAL 2nd GENERATION WINEMAKERS RYAN WALSH & FREYA HOHNEN Vines planted by family 1998 - 100% cab sauv from cooler inland Osmington eastern Margaret River, using bio-dynamic practices 20% handpicked, whole-bunch pressed increasing complexity and weight; no crushing nor destemming. Natural yeasts and left on skins to dry. *Beautiful fresh and alive, expressive style, youthful and a difference to mainstream Margs. cabs. (Unfined/Unfiltered/Vegan)*

Picardy 'tête de cuvée' 2019 Pinot Noir *Pemberton, Gt Southern WA* ▲ 100 ml \$24 ▲ 150 ml \$34 | \$160
EST 1993 PANNELL FAMILY'S RENOWNED PINOT NOIR BY BILL PANNELL (SENIOR) & SON, DAN PANNELL— *(Founders of Moss Wood Vineyard, Margaret River '70's) Tête de Cuvée=Best of Vintage - always impressive, one of Australia's great pinot noirs.*

Swinney 'farvie' 2020 syrah *Frankland River WA* ▲ 100 ml \$35 ▲ 150 ml \$50 | \$240
SWINNEY FAMILY PROPERTY BY GEORGE SWINNEY 1920 2ND GEN. GRAHAM & KAY & 3RD GEN. MATT & JANELLE NOW RESIDENTS. VINEYARDS PLANTED '90'S. WINEMAKER ROB MANN— *"An utterly gorgeous nose awaits. Ferrous, blood plum, rust, pastrami, blackberries, black cherries, mulberries. Concentrated, textured, with fine-grit tannins. Deep Woods Estate Reserve 2020 Cab Sauv *Margaret River* ▲ 100 ml \$28 ▲ 150 ml \$40 | \$190
EST 1987 BY PETER FOGARTY, LOCAL WINEMAKER JULIAN LANGWORTHY *Inky dark colour, bright crimson, purple hues. Aromas 'A supreme example of 2020 Margaret River cabernet. Concentrated yet elegantly structured fruit. It comes from the Abbey Vale vineyard and the Yallingup Hills. Brilliant bright colour gives the first indication of its vital brightness. The aromas show those leafy bay leaf and dark chocolate characters. The palate weaves together seamlessly, with fine tannins and ample oak harnessing the powerful persistent fruit. McHenry Hohen 'hazel's vineyard' 2016 Cab Sauv *Margaret River, WA* ▲ 100 ml \$15 ▲ 150 ml \$21 | \$100
EST 1984 FOUNDER OWNER MURRAY MCHENRY - HEAD WINEMAKER, JACOPO "JAPO" DALLI CANI -100% Single Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon - biodynamically farmed, southernmost vineyard characterised by a cooling Southern Ocean influence giving regional and varietal expression – *classic blackcurrant, cedar, dried herb, depth of fruit, grip, fine, tannins.* 6 years cellaring ~pure drinkability.

Voyager Estate 'MJW' 2014 Cab Sauv *Margaret River WA* ▲ 100 ml \$35 ▲ 150 ml \$50 | \$240
EST 1978 MICHAEL J. WRIGHT (1937-2012 RIP) -NOW RUN BY DAUGHTER ALEXANDRA BURT. WINEMAKERS TRAVIS LEMM & TOM SHAND Very best barrels from North Block 12 & Old Block V9, original '78 plantings. Mostly Cab Sauv with some Petit Verdot gives aromatic complexity. *"Silky fruit, herbal tannins, plenty of savoury spice – heading for a long life +2034"*~ Wine Enthusiast

EST '01 BY PEABODY FAMILY - CHIEF WINEMAKER WA BORN JULIAN GROUNDS SINCE 2019 VINTAGE - FORMER VINTAGES MARGARET RIVER, OREGON, CENTRAL OTAGO, YARRA VALLEY— *'Intensity drive, rich at the core, ample soft fine tannins. Farrside by Farr 2019 Pinot Noir *Geelong, Vic* ▲ 100 ml \$24 ▲ 150 ml \$34 | \$150
EST '94 BY FAMED WINEMAKER GARY FARR / WITH SON NICK TAKING OVER WINEMAKING— Gary Farr is one of the most iconic winemakers in Vic, and Aus., responsible for taking Bannockburn, Geelong to startling heights. Farrside, made by Gary, spends around 18mos in barrels, 60% of them made from new wood: it's a far higher percentage than any other wine made in the Farr estate, possibly a heritage of Gary's youth in Burgundy at Domaine Dujac. *'Concentrated rich red/dark cherry, red plum, strawberry fruits, spicy vanillin cedar, light dried herb, meaty forest floor, silky structured tannins, long aftertaste.'* Winery notes

'GOURMET TRAVELLER WINE' YOUNG WINEMAKER OF THE YEAR 2006— Wines of purity & detail reflecting their place of origin & made in the most natural way possible, minimal intervention winemaking. The stunning bottles are from low carbon- neutral footprint source. *"Spicy, savoury, earthy, black cherry powerful texture, cedary flavour a definite bet for the cellar."*

Wendouree 2017 shiraz-malbec *Clare Valley, SA* ▲ 100 ml \$24 ▲ 150 ml \$34 | \$150
EST 1895 - ONE OF AUSTRALIA'S MOST HISTORIC PROPERTIES - CUSTODIANS / WINEMAKER TONY AND LITA BRADY- FAMILY WINERY— Very old vineyards, unique terroir, by custodians Tony & Lita Brady. The 100yo stone winery is virtually unchanged from the day it was built; in every sense a treasure beyond price.
