Bodegas Exopto 'bozeto de exopto' rosado 2022 garnacha | tempranillo DRY ROSÉ Rioja SP 150 ml \$12 | \$55
BY TOM PUYAUBERT EX CÔTES DE PROVENCE, FRANCE channelling the chalky, textural, delicate pastille colour of Provence rosé in Los Pozos a single plot 50yo vines, chalky soils of San Vicente de la Sonsierra, Rioja, Spain. *6mos on lees - bright tangy rosado with silky white peach, strawberry fruit, subtle textural grip, vibrant freshness.*

WINEMAKER ROBERT DILETTIE AND HIS PARENTS PLANTED VINEYARDS IN 1983 **BEST PINOT NOIR - GOLD TROPHY, 2023 Perth Royal Wine Show**
"Thoroughly beautiful example Gt Southern pinot noir. Immense power, flavour of this variety in a very good vintage, degree of subtle finesse, intense strawberry fruits, savoury elements, seamless, fine lingering acidity, statement". '96pts Ray Jordan

BILL DOWNIE ESTABLISHED HIS OWN LABEL IN 2003 AFTER WORKING IN BURGUNDY SEVERAL YEARS. His intention is to produce wines of purity and detail that reflect place of origin, made in the most natural way as possible. Blend of 70% Mornington Peninsula /30% King Valley, beautiful organic fruit. *Aromatic, lively, bright, red/dark berry fruit, spicy, finesse, subtle tannins. (Unfined/Unfiltered/Vegan)*

◆ **Cruse Wine Co 'monkey jacket' 2020 {flagship blend}** North Coast Sonoma Ca, USA 100 ml \$1150 ◆ 150 ml \$1650 | \$80
BY WINEMAKER MICHAEL RORICK, PETALUMA WINERY Mendocino/Sonoma/Napa/Suisun Counties late summer sunny-dry blend/ some confit'd fruit: 53% valdiguié (gamay-like Languedoc clone) 14% old-vine carignan +23% red field blend. 25% fermented whole cluster. All grapes concrete fermented, pressed to older French oak barrels & concrete tanks, keeping fruit transparency. Nat. malo, light sulfur before bottling. *Bright ruby rim, rich burgundy hues, youthful, serious crushed strawberry bramble, bass notes olive, leather. Lingering clean fresh raspberry, rhubarb finish.*

◆ **Vasse Felix 2022 syrah (shiraz)** Margaret River WA 100 ml \$10 ◆ 150 ml \$1350 | \$65
EST '67 FIRST WINERY REGIONAL PIONEER TOM CULLITY, NOW OWNED BY HOLMES À COURT FAMILY SINCE '87. WINEMAKER VIRGINIA WILLCOCK
Cool climate southern Margaret River vineyards— a portion of whole bunch fermentation and carbonic maceration—*aromatic, fine-boned Syrah, luscious, spicy, beautifully complex, a favourite 'alternative' Margaret River red varieties. Vegan*

◆ **The Next 100 Years 2020 syrah** Frankland River, Gt Southern, WA 100 ml \$9 ◆ 150ml \$1250 | \$60
BY LOCAL TERRY CHELLAPPAH & WINEMAKER VANESSA CARLSON Wilkes Vineyard 20yo shiraz vines, ironstone gravel, to French oak with 2% fermented viognier. Cool climate syrah gives spice, aromatics; black, red fruits, brush of liquorice, vanilla oak.

◆ **McHenry Hohnen 'hazel's vineyard' 2021 grenache | syrah | mataro** Margaret River 100 ml \$10 ◆ 150 ml \$1350 | \$65
EST 1984 FOUNDER MURRAY MCHENRY - WINEMAKER, JACOPO "JAPO" DALLICANI -CERTIFIED ORGANIC, FARMED BIODYNAMICALLY
Grenache & mataro regional rarities. *"Classic S. Rhône blend bursts with aromas mulberry, cherry, spice."* 96pts Halliday

◆ **Wines of Merritt 2022 mourvèdre** Wilyabrup, Margaret River 100 ml \$10 ◆ 150 ml \$1350 | \$65
SMALL BATCH WINES BY LOCALS NICK & SARAH JAMES-MARTIN they handpicked the grapes over 2 days, late April '22. Half whole bunch fermented, half destemmed, both foot trod; indigenous yeast; basket pressed to Fr oak. Bottled without fining nor filtration.
Mouvèdre originally planted in Spain over 2,000 years ago – this wine has the distinct 'mouvèdre' personality - *strong tannic structure, quite dark-fruited and spicy, with gamey, wild herb aromas. (Vegan)*

◆ **Nocturne 2022 'SR5 Cabernets - Yallingup Sub Region'** Margaret River 100 ml \$10 ◆ 150 ml \$1450 | \$70
SMALL FAMILY WINERY PROJECT BY LOCAL WINEMAKER JULIAN LANGWORTHY - 69% Cabernet Sauvignon from their own Sheoak Vineyard, with 21% Merlot 21% / 10% Malbec from their neighbour - which were then settled together clarified and bottled.
A delicious cassis laden expression of a cabernet blend that's just right – great drinkability, complexity and verve.

Swinney 'farvie' 2020 syrah *Frankland River, WA* ▲ 100 ml \$35 ▲ 150 ml \$50 | \$240
FAMILY PROPERTY EST 1920 BY GEORGE SWINNEY - 3rd GEN. MATT & JANELLE PLANTED VINEYARDS '90s - WINEMAKER ROB MANN—
"An utterly gorgeous nose awaits. Ferrous, blood plum, rust, pastrami, black-berries, black cherries, mulberries. Concentrated, textured, with fine-grit tannins. EST 1984 FOUNDER OWNER MURRAY McHENRY - HEAD WINEMAKER, JACOPO "JAPO" DALLI CANI - 100% Single Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon - biodynamically farmed, southernmost vineyard characterised by a cooling Southern Ocean influence giving regional, varietal expression - *classic blackcurrant, cedar, dried herb, depth of fruit, grip, fine, tannins.* 6 years cellaring ~pure drinkability.

Voyager Estate 'MJW' 2014 cabernet sauvignon *Margaret River WA* ▲ 100 ml \$35 ▲ 150 ml \$50 | \$240
EST 1978 MICHAEL J. WRIGHT (1937-2012 RIP) - NOW RUN BY DAUGHTER ALEXANDRA BURT. WINEMAKERS TRAVIS LEMM & TOM SHAND
Very best barrels from North Block 12 & Old Block V9, original '78 plantings. Mostly Cab Sauv with some Petit Verdot gives aromatic complexity. *"Silky fruit, herbal tannins, plenty of savoury spice - heading for a long life +2034"* ~ Wine Enthusiast

Farrside by Farr 2019 pinot noir *Geelong, Vic* ▲ 100 ml \$24 ▲ 150 ml \$34 | \$150
EST '94 BY FAMED WINEMAKER GARY FARR / WITH SON NICK TAKING OVER WINEMAKING— Gary Farr is one of the most iconic winemakers in Vic. and Aus., responsible for taking Bannockburn, Geelong to startling heights. Farrside, made by Gary, spends around 18mos in barrels, 60% of them made from new wood: it's a far higher percentage than any other wine made in the Farr estate, possibly a heritage of Gary's youth in Burgundy at Domaine Dujac. *'Concentrated rich red/dark cherry, red plum, strawberry fruits, spicy vanillin cedar, light dried herb, meaty forest floor, silky structured tannins, long aftertaste.'* Winery notes

Felton Road 2013 'cornish point' pinot noir *Bannockburn, Central Otago, NZ* ▲ 100 ml \$24 ▲ 150 ml \$34 | \$150
Est 90's BY FARMER STUART ELMS, GENTLE SLOPE AT THE SOUTHERN END OF CENTRAL OTAGO'S CROMWELL BASIN, A TIME WHEN THERE WAS ONLY A HANDFUL OF OTHER VINEYARDS IN THE REGION—Stunning wines, one of the most southerly vineyards on earth. *"Still has a very good, youthful colour, the bouquet is shy, while the palate is big, bold, four-square, gutsy, tannic. The stunning bottles are from low carbon-neutral footprint source. *"Spicy, savoury, earthy, black cherry powerful texture, cedary flavour a definite bet for the cellar."*

EST 1895 - ONE OF AUSTRALIA'S MOST HISTORIC PROPERTIES - CUSTODIANS / WINEMAKER TONY AND LITA BRADY- FAMILY WINERY—
Very old vineyards, unique terroir, by custodians Tony & Lita Brady. The 100yo stone winery is virtually unchanged from the day it was built; in every sense a treasure beyond price. Extraordinary wines, rare & very hard to come by.
