EST 1991 WHEN NEIL PRENTICE SOLD HIS 1957 'STUDEBAKER PRESIDENT' TO BUY THE FENCE POSTS FOR HIS FIRST VINEYARD AT MOONDARRA The vines are grown on deep, volcanic soils, rich in minerals, bringing robust, ferrous (iron) flavour to the pinot. Handpicked, destemmed, crushed, fermented in large oak barrels, so oak influence takes back seat, retaining rich texture, aromatic lift. Approachable, light-bodied, soft, delicate. Slightly tangy acidity, fine tannins. Bright sour, red cherry. Spicy, earthy. Unfined/Unfiltered/Vegan

♦ **Kéké Descombes 'cuvée kéké' 2019 beaujolais (gamay)** Beaujolais FR 100 ml \$10 ♦ 150 ml \$1350 | \$65

Kewan (Kéké) has Beaujolais in his blood - one of the regions brightest young talents; son of the famed Georges Descombes Est 1988, his wines are among the finest, most consistent in Beaujolais. Textbook Beaujolais aromas blueberries, earth, flowers, iodine. Clean, bright, wonderfully pure. Juicy ripe fruit, slate laced, stems, vibrant acidity, tang ...very hard to stop drinking it! Dense, dark blue fruits, fennel and raspberry acidity. Rich and spicy yet elegant (unfined/vegan)

EST '67 FIRST WINERY REGIONAL PIONEER TOM CULLITY, NOW OWNED BY HOLMES À COURT FAMILY SINCE '87. WINEMAKER VIRGINIA WILLCOCK Cool climate southern Margaret River vineyards— part whole bunch fermentation and carbonic maceration—aromatic, bright fine-boned Syrah, luscious, spicy, beautifully complex — a favourite 'alt' Margaret River red varietal. Sustainably farmed/Vegan

♦ **Wines of Merritt 2022 mourvèdre** Wilyabrup, Margaret River 100 ml \$10 ♦ 150 ml \$1350 | \$65

SMALL BATCH WINES BY LOCALS NICK & SARAH JAMES-MARTIN they handpicked the grapes over 2 days, late April '22. Half whole bunch fermented, half destemmed, both foot trod; indigenous yeast; basket pressed to Fr oak. Bottled without fining nor filtration. Mourvèdre originally planted in Spain over 2,000 years ago – this wine has the distinct 'mourvèdre' personality - strong tannic structure, quite dark-fruited and spicy, with gamey, wild herb aromas. (Vegan)

♦ **Nocturne 'SR5 Cabernets' 2022 'Yallingup Sub Region'** Margaret River 100 ml \$10 ♦ 150 ml \$1450 | \$70

EST 2017 - SMALL PROJECT LIMITED QTY WINES BY LOCAL WINEMAKER JULIAN LANGWORTHY 69% Cabernet Sauvignon from his own Sheoak Vineyard... with 21% Merlot & 10% Malbec from his neighbour - which were then settled together clarified and bottled. A delicious cassis laden expression of a cabernet blend that's just right – great drinkability, complexity, verve.

Certified: Organic & Biodynamic viticulture/carbon neutral. *'Hand-picked, whole bunch-pressed, wild yeast fermented in FR oak for 5 mos. Texture; supple, round – prodigiously long finish, aftertaste.'* ~97 Pts Halliday— S/o at Cellar Door

 2<sup>nd</sup> vintage, small project, limited release grown on tiny plot, site-specific expression, truly unique, the coolest pocket of their site in the Wallcliffe area, 'J Plot' sits between a tributary for the Boodjidup Creek and vineyard dam. *Jasmine floral scents, oyster-like salinity, limestone minerality, an outstanding parcel, too special not to share. Older, lighter oak celebrating elegance, finesse, searing natural acidity, lighter-framed, pristine Chardonnay.* ~ sustainable farming/vegan

**Xanadu 'steven's road' 21 chardonnay Margaret River WA**      ▲ 100 ml \$24 ▲ 150 ml \$35 | \$160 Btl

## White Wine - Australia / Italy

**Fletcher 'della stazione' 2022 vermentino {favorita} Langhe, Piedmont, Italy**      ▲ 100 ml \$1250 ▲ 150 ml \$1750 | \$85 Btl  
 DAVE FLETCHER – ADELAIDE BORN, SELF-CONFESSIONED NEBBIOLO ADDICT – MOVED TO PIEDMONT 2007 TO FOLLOW HIS PASSION – NOW MAKES HIS OWN WINES IN THE OLD BARBARESCO TRAIN STATION ~ FAVORITA, NEBBIOLO, BARBERA, DOLCETTO, BARBARESCO  
 60 yo (ancient Piedmont grape) Favorita vineyard, Bricco Capre, San Rocco, Alba. Harvested very early to preserve freshness and acidity, 2<sup>nd</sup> run focus on fruity intensity – very fresh, perfectly ripe; indigenous yeasts, whole bunch to Burgundy barrels 8mos on fine lees, unfined, unfiltered, vegan. *Absolutely fascinating wine, a delight to taste, utterly absorbing to drink. Salty, electric, silky glide. The fruit is incredibly intense, bright and tangy. Ripe, but mouth-watering.* ~Distributor notes.

**Mount Mary 'triolet' 2015 'white Bordeaux blend' Yarra Valley, Vic**      ▲ 100 ml \$23 ▲ 150 ml \$32 | \$150 Btl  
 EST 1971 BY THE LATE DR. JOHN MIDDLETON FOUNDER & ESTEEMED INSTIGATOR (WITH THE LATE DR BAILEY CARRODUS, YARRA YERING)  
 hailing back to early '70's revival of Yarra Valley wine region. Vyds planted 1972. "Grandson, Sam Middleton carries on legacy as winemaker. 65/21/14% % blend of sauv blanc, semillon & muscadelle; hand-picked, destemmed, lightly crushed; different cultured yeast strains each parcel, 100% barrel-ferment, matured 11mos in oak. " *This is an uncommonly rich Triolet at its early stage, but that is all to the good, for it will mature majestically as all the vintages that preceded it have done.* ~96pts James Halliday

**Grosset 'piccadilly' 2019' chardonnay Yarra Valley, Vic**      ▲ 100 ml \$18 ▲ 150 ml \$25 | \$120 Btl  
 Est 1981 JEFFREY GROSSET OWNER & WINEMAKER, RENOWNED WINERY *"This is smokin'. It has moreish sulphides at play, but it's the bringing together and syncing of all its elements that makes this spot-on. White nectarines, citrus, creamed honey, spice - offset by mouth-watering acidity. It's layered, concentrated and flatteringly fine."* ~96pts Jane Faulkner, Halliday
