Graci Etna rosato 2022/24 narello mascalese *{pale-dry-spicy}* Etna, Sicily IT \$65 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$1350 ▲ 100 ml \$10  
BY ELENA GRACI & BROTHER ALBERTO Northern slopes, Mt Etna, indigenous viticulture dates back to the 3rd century.  
1800-3000ft above sea level. Fine example of Etna Rosato – light crush, no maceration, fermented with indigenous yeast.  
Light summer berry aromas, stony edge, intense juicy, mineral, cherry, great balance. **Unfined / Vegan**

Delicate, aromatic – red cherry, plum roasted red pepper. Med. body, fine grain tannins, refreshing acidity. Balanced savoury notes crushed gravel spiced chocolate finish. **Lightweight sustainable bottle / minimal intervention / unfined / Vegan**

Heady violets, mulberries, fresh herbs with rolled tobacco and some nori, even blueberry muffins of all things, plus cedar oak. Tangy, ripe red cherries, warming spices; bright, juicy lively acidity keeps it refreshing; feathery-light tannins add shape. A lovely drink."* ~Jane Faulkner, Halliday

#### \*Grosset 'gaia' 2009 cabernet sauvignon w/cabernet franc Clare Valley, SA

EST 1981 JEFFREY GROSSET ESTATE-OWNED VINEYARDS 35+yo VINES - HALLIDAY'S BEST WINEMAKER OF THE YEAR 2022.
