EST1997 BY JUDE & GARY BERSON Cellar Door & vineyards located Cowaramup nth of Margaret River township, vines planted without irrigation, emulating those of Margaret River pioneers (incl. Moss Wood). *“Med bodied wine showing that pinot noir can work rather well in Margaret River. Tangy, ripe red cherries, warming spices; bright, juicy lively acidity keeps it refreshing; feathery-light tannins add shape. A lovely drink.”* ~Jane Faulkner, Halliday

***Picardy ‘tête de cuvée’ 2022 pinot noir** *Pemberton, Gt Southern WA* **\$170 Btl ▲ 150ml \$34 | ▲ 100 ml \$24**

BY 3 CO-FOUNDERS BRAD & JODEE ADAMS, WITH FRENCH WINEMAKER EMMANUEL POIRMEUR **2nd Immersion** of southern Hemisphere’s 1st open-ocean winery, where wines are stirred by Southern Ocean’s energy using specially designed WineReef vats lowered into the pristine Flinders Bay waters; at a depth of 20m constant motion pressure works its maritime magic creating wines with a character impossible to replicate on land. *‘Big, bold, cherry, dark berries, hints of pepper, spice. EST 1971 BY KEVIN & DIANA CULLEN - WINEMAKER: VANYA CULLEN *“Diana Madeline. The name evokes a lot of emotions, for what the woman stood for then and what the wine stands for now. The 2021 vintage equals 50 years of cabernet sauvignon plantings at Cullen. When released in early 2023, it was on what would have been her 100th birthday. It’s a wine that can come from nowhere else, so strong is its sense of place. It’s complex, complete, structured. Gosh, what a wine. What a woman. EST 1984 FOUNDER OWNER MURRAY McHENRY - HEAD WINEMAKER, JACOPO “JAP0” DALLI CANI – 100% Single Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon - biodynamically farmed, southernmost vineyard characterised by a cooling Southern Ocean influence giving regional, varietal expression – Fermented in concrete, matured for 16 months in French oak (30% new). *“Graphite, cassis, mulberry, briny acidity, layers of exotic spice.”* ~ 97Pts Erin Larkin, Halliday. -Drink 22 – 2038 Organic & Biodynamic / vegan

Dujac).* *“A patch of land near Henty, where wild weather, ancient soils conspire to make Pinot Noir unlike anywhere else in Australia. Sit back and take in the aromas from a glass of this pinot as you think about sitting at the top of the vineyard surrounded by cows, water, grass and all things Western District farming. Sweet and sour cherries, earth, spice and a lovely elegant structure.”* ~Nick Farr - winemaker notes

Stargazer Wine ‘Palisander’ 2023 pinot noir *Coal River Valley, Tas* **\$130 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$27 ▲ 100 ml \$19**
EST 2012 BY SAMANTHA CONNOW ...one of the country’s most respected wine judges, and influential voices in the Australian wine industry. A one-woman show, focused around her small vineyard/Cellar Door, Coal River Valley, making tiny parcels of: Riesling, Chardonnay & Pinot Noir. *‘Beautifully pure, flint-struck, concentrated, grace, drinkability. Wild strawberry, dark cherry fruits, five-spice, dried citrus rind, rose petals, savoury; elegant, harmonious, gunpowder reduction flavours – complex, interesting; saline, mineral great length of flavour.’* ~96Pts Halliday

Serrat 2018 shiraz/viognier *Yarra Valley Vic* **\$140 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$29 ▲ 100 ml \$20**
EST 2001 TOM & NADEGE CARSON’S OWN PROPERTY (TOM CARSON WINEMAKER AT YABBY LAKE) 16yo vines, hand-picked, bunch-sorted, open-fermented together 90% whole berries/10% whole bunches, 14 days on skins, 11mos Fr Oak (25% new) *“Enticing, but it’s the palate that makes the wine, black cherry flavours and texture woven together from start to finish, the aftertaste lingering for minutes.”* ~ Award Winning Varietal, Halliday Wine Companion Awards 2021 - Drink to ‘38

***Jasper Hill ‘georgia’s paddock’ 2010 shiraz** *Heathcote, Vic* **\$130 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$27 ▲ 100 ml \$19**
EST 1979 BY RON & ELVA LAUGHTON Renowned small winery, true pioneers, icons in central Victorian wine region of the Heathcote. *“Med-bodied wine, complex equal flavours, texture, structure; black cherry, spice liquorice flavours soar on the finish.”* ~Langton’s classification.

***Grosset ‘gaia’ 2013 cabernet sauvignon w/cabernet franc** *Clare Valley, SA* **\$180 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$37 ▲ 100 ml \$25**
EST 1981 JEFFREY GROSSET ESTATE-OWNED VINEYARDS 35+yo VINES - HALLIDAY’S BEST WINEMAKER OF THE YEAR 2022. *75% cab/25% cab franc. “Bouquet has a haunting edge of fruit spice and FR oak; palate very complex amalgam of juicy black fruits and gently etched tannins, waft of Provence herbs on the aftertaste.”* ~Tasting notes: re-tasted 2021 by Halliday ~95Pts – Drink 2021-38+ Cert: Organic/Biodynamic
