- Nocturne 'SR' 2025 sangiovese | tempranillo rosé** {intense-textural-dry} Margaret River **\$65 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$1350 ▲ 100 ml \$10**

 BY ANDREW DAWSON, WINEMAKER LOCAL SMALL FAMILY WINERY, MAKING SOME GREAT WINES. Sourcing grapes from single vineyards across WA—Spanish grape Graciano relatively rare in Australia, but here it is in Karridale 32 yo dry-grown vines, handpicked whole berry ferment, basket pressed, 12mos in French oak... *delicious—dark fruits, fine tannin, bright acidity, wrapped in a layer of seductive, exotic spice.* Unfined/ unfiltered/ Vegan.
- ◆ **Stargazer 'rada' 2024/25 pinot noir | pinot meunier** Coal River, Tasmania **\$65 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$1350 ▲ 100 ml \$10**  
 EST. '13 SAMANTHA CONNEW, SMALL PRODUCER, HIGHLY RESPECTED WINEMAKER (CHAIRMAN OF JUDGES, SYDNEY ROYAL WINE SHOW)  
 Pinot Meunier (dark-berried savoury earthy, spicy) the grape variety most famously used in the Champagne blend, shares same DNA as Pinot Noir (soft red berry fruits). *Together give: soft, dusty tannins, Tassie acidity, liveliness and energy.*
- ◆ **William Downie 'Tolmie' 2025 pinot noir** Tolmie, Upper Goulburn Vic **\$65 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$1350 ▲ 100 ml \$10**  
 BILL DOWNIE EST. Now run by 2<sup>nd</sup> generation Hunter Smith (viticulturist), sister Elizabeth Smith & her husband Brian Kent Winemaker. "Shiraz vineyards set in the deep majestic region, giving the essence of pure shiraz fruit; soft, plush, dark cherry, mocha, salted liquorice, mint, spices, slightly minerally—harmony and pleasing tannin." ~Mike Bennie, Halliday Cert org/vegan
- ◆ **Vallee du Venom 2023 malbec** Margaret River WA **\$65 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$1350 ▲ 100 ml \$10**  
 LOCAL 'YOUNG GUN OF WINE' RHYS PARKER - SMALL PROJECT SOURCING GRAPES ACROSS THE REGION Fruit sourced from their Cowaramup Vineyard. *Delicate, poised expression of the vineyard - cherry, plum skin, crushed gravel aromas. Full palate mulberry, boysenberry vanilla oak flavours. "Juicy very quaffable easy-going style that should please just about anyone."* ~Rhys *Small batch/ min. intervention / min. sulphur/ unfined/ unfiltered/ vegan*

"Savoury, tangy, juicy—cherries, plums, blood orange, chinotto—sinewy tannins, bright acidity. A food wine!" ~Liv & Mij notes

- Moss Wood 'autrement' 2024 pinot noir** *Karridale Vineyards, Margaret River* **\$95 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$20 ▲ 100 ml \$1350**  
 SINCE 1979 BY CLARE & KEITH MUGFORD "Autrement" is the French word for "in another way"— "Southern Karridale Vineyards, the flavour profile clearly differs from our Willyabrup fruit, cooler temperatures, later ripening contribute to a wine with fine structure, bright acidity, savoury complexity. *Bright crimson, with inviting aromas of red cherry pie, ripe sweetness, tangy acidity backbone, velvety tannins that grip until the end.*" ~Winemaker
- \*Picardy 'tête de cuvée' 2022 pinot noir** *Pemberton, Gt Southern WA* **\$170 Btl ▲ 150ml \$34 | ▲ 100 ml \$24**  
 EST 1993 PANNELL FAMILY'S RENOWNED PINOT NOIR BY BILL PANNELL (SENIOR) & SON, DAN PANNELL— (Founders of Moss Wood, Margaret River '70's) Tête de Cuvée=Best of Vintage One of Australia's great pinot noirs. *"Wow, this is something very special!"* ~99 Pts Ray Jordan -Drink now- '35+
- \*Subsea Estate 'pure' 2024 shiraz** *Margaret River & Flinders Bay, Augusta* **\$120 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$24 ▲ 100 ml \$18**  
 BY 3 CO-FOUNDERS BRAD & JODEE ADAMS, WITH FRENCH WINEMAKER EMMANUEL POIRMEUR *2nd Immersion* of southern Hemisphere's 1<sup>st</sup> open-ocean winery, where wines are stirred by Southern Ocean's energy using specially designed WineReef vats lowered into the pristine Flinders Bay waters; at a depth of 20m constant motion pressure works its maritime magic creating wines with a character impossible to replicate on land. *'Big, bold, cherry, dark berries, hints of pepper, spice. Intense fruit-driven wine, with subtle oak for soft yet powerful tannin finish.'* Winemaker notes.
- \*Cullen Wines 'Diana Madeline' 2022 cabernet blend** *Margaret River* **\$290 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$59 ▲ 100 ml \$39\***  
 EST 1971 BY KEVIN & DIANA CULLEN - WINEMAKER: VANYA CULLEN *"Diana Madeline. The name evokes a lot of emotions, for what the woman stood for then and what the wine stands for now. The 2021 vintage equals 50 years of cabernet sauvignon plantings at Cullen. When released in early 2023, it was on what would have been her 100th birthday. It's a wine that can come from nowhere else, so strong is its sense of place. It's complex, complete, structured. Gosh, what a wine. What a woman. - McHenry Hohnen 'hazel's vineyard' 2020 cab sauv** *Margaret River* **\$125 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$26 ▲ 100 ml \$17**  
 EST 1984 FOUNDER OWNER MURRAY McHENRY - HEAD WINEMAKER, JACOPO "JAPO" DALLICANI – 100% Single Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon - biodynamically farmed, southernmost vineyard characterised by a cooling Southern Ocean influence giving regional, varietal expression – Fermented in concrete, matured for 16 months in French oak (30% new). *"Graphite, cassis, mulberry, briny acidity, layers of exotic spice."* ~ 97Pts Erin Larkin, Halliday. -Drink 22 – 2038 Organic & Biodynamic / vegan
- Nocturne Wines 2024 SV 'sheoak vineyard' cabernet sauvignon** *Margaret River* **\$140 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$29 ▲ 100 ml \$20**  
 EST 2007 SMALL PROJECT BY WINEMAKER JULIAN LANGWORTHY Yallingup, MR's most northerly, warmest sub-region, 4ha Sheoak Vyd sth. facing, 2.7 ha cane-pruned 20+yo vines planted on deep gravel, loam soils over clay, moderated by fresh Indian Ocean breezes. "Such a distinctive wine, floral, pretty at first. Violets, cassis, mulberries, tobacco, menthol, cedary oak, spices – all you'd expect from this region. Yet it's the palate that links it to plac- Sheoak Vyd. Beautifully ripe, fine tannins, exceptionally long finish, another classy cabernet.~96Pts Jane Faulkner-Halliday Drink 26-44

- \*Bindi Wine 'Dixon' 2022 pinot noir** *Gisbourne, Macedon Ranges Vic* **\$140 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$29 ▲ 100 ml \$20**  
 EST 1988 BY THE LATE BILL DHILLON & SON MICHAEL DHILLON "WINEMAKER of the YEAR – WINE COMPANION 2022 "Bindi" 50 km north west from Melbourne – Dhillon family property, originally purchased in 1950's. Soils shattered quartz over siltstone, sandstone, clay, 480 million year old Ordovician period sub soils; eroded volcanic top soil over clay 4 million year old soils. 10mos in barrel. Part original 1988 vines & Kayes 2001. *"There's a clear DNA link to the pinots from Bindi – from aromas to palate. Wines of place. Complex, silky, flowing."* ~95Pts Halliday Drink 2025-35+ Cert: Org/Biodynamic
- Bubb + Pooley 23 pinot noir** *Coal River Valley, TAS* **\$95 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$20 ▲ 100 ml \$1350**  
 EST 2021 JOINT VENTURE BY JUSTIN BUBB (BABO WINES) & ANNA POOLEY (POOLEY WINES) who've been making wine all over the world for 20 years. Beautiful example of 25 yo vines on their "WKR" vineyard at White Kangaroo Road, Coal River Valley. *Powerful, cellar-worthy style, combining plush, dark-cherried fruit with ample tannin and a good supporting, judiciously applied FR oak. Savoury, supple, very limited,* Winemaker notes unfinned / vegan
- \*Jasper Hill 'georgia's paddock' 2010 shiraz** *Heathcote, Vic* **\$130 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$27 ▲ 100 ml \$19**  
 EST 1979 BY RON & ELVA LAUGHTON Renowned small winery, true pioneers, icons in central Victorian wine region of the Heathcote. *"Med-bodied wine, complex equal flavours, texture, structure; black cherry, spice liquorice flavours soar on the finish."* ~Langton's classification.
- \*Grosset 'gaia' 2013 cabernet sauvignon w/ cabernet franc** *Clare Valley, SA* **\$180 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$37 ▲ 100 ml \$25**  
 EST 1981 JEFFREY GROSSET ESTATE-OWNED VINEYARDS 35+yo VINES - HALLIDAY'S BEST WINEMAKER OF THE YEAR 2022. *75% cab/25% cab franc. "Bouquet has a haunting edge of fruit spice and FR oak; palate very complex amalgam of juicy black fruits, gently etched tannins, waft of Provence herbs on the aftertaste."* ~Tasting notes: re-tasted 2021 by Halliday ~95Pts – *Drink 2021-38+* Cert: Organic/Biodynamic
- \*Yarra Yering 'Dry Red No. 3' 2020 Portuguese blend** *Yarra Valley, Vic* **\$150 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$32 ▲ 100 ml \$22**  
 EST 1969 BY THE LATE DR BAILEY CARRODUS OWNER-WINEMAKER Winemaker Sarah Crowe since 2013. Dr Bailey's 1990 plantings of Portuguese grape varieties chosen as being suitable for a warm, dry, west facing vineyard; terraced to the contours of the slope it provides conditions the vines have been bred for centuries. Handpicked, co-fermented, foot trod. *35% touriga nacional, 35% tinta cao, 12% tinta roriz + tinta amarela, avarelhao, sousao. "This 'one-of-a-kind' wine is beautifully perfumed— mountain herbs, lavender, rosemary, briary red fruits. Balanced palate, immediately appealing—gentle texture, refreshing acidity, superfine tannin structure."* ~96Pts Phillip Rich, Halliday – Drink to 2030 Dry grown/ sustainable
