- Dukes Vineyard 'single vineyard' 2026 shiraz rosé {dry-elegant-spicy}** Porongorup, Gt Southern WA **\$45 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$950**
BEN CANE & PARTNER SARAH DATE purchased Duke's Vineyard when founders (1999) Duke and Hilde Ranson decided to retire in 2022.
Slightly savoury, spicy shiraz, with some elegant cabernet and touch of bright fresh riesling.
- ◆ **Bodegas Exopto 'bozeta de exopto' 2024 garnacha /tempranillo {chalky-textural-dry}** Rioja DOCa, Spain **\$60 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$13 ▲ 100 ml \$9**
BY TOM PUYAUBERT EX CÔTES DE PROVENCE, FRANCE channelling the chalky, textural, delicate pastille colour of Provence rosé in Rioja,
50yo vines, chalky soils, true expression of the region's rich, vibrant terroir. Bright tangy, silky white peach, strawberry, vibrant freshness.
- ◆ **La Cache Estate 2009 sparkling shiraz 'methode traditionnelle' Margaret River** ◆ **Sparkling red by Coravin** **\$60 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$1250**
EST '96 BY LOCAL JOHN FRAZER, WINEMAKER. Frazer Woods Vineyard, situated in the highly acclaimed local Wilyabrup sub region.
Aged on lees 5-8yrs Medium-bodied, rich ruby, spicy, complex, mellow, soft, gentle tannins. Delicious, unique local treat.

- Bistro Rouge 2024 cabernet sauvignon** Cowaramup, Margaret River **\$39 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$9**
BY LOCAL WINEMAKER CLÉMENCE HASELGROVE 30+yo Single Vineyard Cabernet, 8mos in French oak, minimal intervention shows the purity of fruit,
and expression of place. Complex, fresh fruit aromas, savoury notes. Soft vibrant flavours, classic rich dark red fruit, leather, soft fine tannins.

BY REKNOWN WA WINEMAKER MIKE GARLAND & SON CALLUM "BURNING VIOLINS his favourite Leonard Cohen song drawing similarity
to the difficulties (but also beauty) of this challenging instrument /this very difficult variety —when on-song, it "Dances you to the end of love."
Wignall's vineyard planted 1982 iconic history of Pinot Noir in WA, on unique "Lyre" trellis. Very rich, complex; some whole bunch: confectionary
notes, stalky complexity. Earthy mushroom notes, FR oak savouriness. Fine tannins, texture, structure. Winemaker notes **Unfined/vegan**
- ◆ **Leeuwin Estate 'siblings' 2024 shiraz** Margaret River **\$55 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$12 ▲ 100 ml \$9**
EST '73 BY LOCAL HORGAN FAMILY, ONE OF REGIONS FOUNDING WINERIES. Dark purple with a red shimmer. Concentrated mulberries, boysenberries
and subtle oak, rich palate, dark cherries, plums and raspberries. Dark chocolate tannins, hints of anise, balanced and elegant.
- ◆ **Frankland Estate 2024 shiraz** Frankland River, Gt. Southern, WA **\$65 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$1350 ▲ 100 ml \$10**
EST. 1988 BY BARRIE SMITH & JUDI CULLAM —RENOUNED ISOLATION RIDGE VINEYARDS. Now run by 2nd generation Hunter Smith (viticulturist), sister
Elizabeth Smith & her husband Brian Kent Winemaker. "Shiraz vineyards set in the deep majestic region, giving the essence of pure shiraz fruit;
soft, plush, dark cherry, mocha, salted liquorice, mint, spices, slightly minerally—harmony and pleasing tannin." ~Mike Bennie, Halliday **Cert org/vegan**
- ◆ **Flowstone Wine 2024 touriga nacional** Karidale, Margaret River **\$65 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$1350 ▲ 100 ml \$10**
EST '03 WINEMAKERS STUART PYM & JANICE McDONALD, SMALL PROJECT, JUST SOUTH OF MARGARET RIVER TOWN. Touriga Nacional, Portuguese
variety, dark skinned for both dry red wines and fortified wines (Port). Bold dark fruit flavours, cabernet like, with hints of spice, leather, violet.
- ◆ **Deep Woods Estate 2024 cabernet franc** Yallingup Hills, Margaret River **\$65 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$1350 ▲ 100 ml \$10**
EST 1987 BY PETER FOGARTY & FAMILY, LOCAL WINEMAKER JULIAN LANGWORTHY One of France's oldest red wine grape, 1st planted 700 years ago;
one of the six red grapes allowed in Bordeaux blended wine—however, as a standalone produces complex delicious wines, approachable on
release, softer tannins, medium body inviting aromatics—a vibrant, modern style, highly perfumed, complex, generous palate, fine, velvety tannins.
- ◆ **Voyager Estate 'coastal' 2025 cabernet sauvignon** Margaret River **\$65 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$1350 ▲ 100 ml \$10**
OWNED SINCE 1991 BY LOCAL WRIGHT FAMILY, RUN BY 2ND GEN ALEXANDRA BURT—Originally Est.1978 vineyards planted by local Peter Gherardi.
Stevens Valley, estate vineyards farmed organically ~wines that reflect the maritime climate's moderating influence, natural acidity and elegance.
Perfumed red and black berries, bay leaf, subtle oak. Concentrated fruit flavours, fresh tannins, crunchy acidity. **Cert Organic vineyards / vegan**
- ◆ **Lapis Luna {Stone+Moon} 2023 zinfandel 85% /barbera 15%** Mendocino, California USA **\$75 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$16 ▲ 100 ml \$11**
EST 1999 BY NICOLE WALSH Pauli Ranch, Mendocino northern California (coastal town north west of Napa and Sonoma.) Cool coastal breezes and
ideal grape-growing conditions, unique, diverse terroir, wines of distinct character, complexity, intense flavours retaining good acidity.
50/50 French/American Oak. Rich, dark,, lush blueberry, plums, blackberry cobbler. Smooth finish, long, juicy. A pinot noir lovers wine.
- ◆ **Fattoria Rodano 2021 chianti classico sangiovese 90% + colorino + canaiolo** Castellina, Tuscany IT **\$75 Btl ▲ 150 ml \$16 ▲ 100 ml \$11**
RODANO FARM EST 1958 BY POZZESI FAMILY w/ LEGENDARY WINEMAKER GUILIO GAMBELLI, NOW 3RD GEN. ENRICO POZZESI. Family owned farm in the heart
of Chianti Classico, organically farmed, traditional Chianti made with natural yeasts, min. intervention, hand-tended. Brimming succulent, earthy
bright red cherries, gentle hints of tobacco; med-bodied, refreshing with glorious fruit on the palate, fine structure. ~Dist. Notes. **Cert Organic vineyards**
